STALLION SERVICE CONTRACT

Owner of Mare (as appears on registration), herein referred to as "Mare Owner", has engaged one service to _____ for the 200__ breeding season at Whispering Pines Farm. Fee _____

Whispering Pines Farm agrees to perform the services contemplated in this agreement, subject to the following:

- (1) \$ _____ booking fee (part of the breeding fee) is due with this agreement and the balance of the breeding fee plus all unpaid expenses, (including but not limited to the veterinary, farrier, and board) shall be paid as billed, but no later than immediately prior to the mare leaving the farm.
- (2) Mare shall be in a healthy and sound breeding condition. Mare Owner understand that all barren mares must have a clean uterine culture prior to the breeding, either completed before mare enters the farm or at the farm prior to breeding, but at Mare Owner's expense. Mares should be wormed within 60 days of entering the farm, and should be vaccinated for tetanus, influenza, encephalitis, and rhinopneumonitis.
- (3) The mare's vaccination for rhinopneumonitis shall be current within one (1) year, and a booster rhinopneumonitis shall be administered according to the drug manufacturers as the mare progresses through her pregnancy. Failure to vaccinate as required by the drug manufacturer shall void the live foal guarantee, as hereafter provided.
- (4) Proof of negative Coggins test, taken within twelve months shall accompany the mare entering the farm. Also, a copy of the mare's registration papers shall be required at the time of entry. If any of the required tests do not accompany the mare at the time of entry, then Whispering Pines Farm will the test and/or vaccinations to be performed at the Mare Owner's expense.
- (5) Unless otherwise agreed, the end of the breeding season is July 1. In this connection, Whispering Pines Farm agrees to act diligently to settle the mare, but not be responsible if a mare does not settle.
- (6) A live foal is guaranteed from this mating. Should the foal not stand and nurse, the Mare Owner will be entitled to return privileges the following season. However, the breeding fee that has previously been paid is not returnable, in addition to payment for all expenses. The return service in the next breeding season is not transferable to another party. Upon the loss of a foal, the breeding farm shall receive a statement from the attending veterinarian which include the previous vaccination dates of the bred mare, and shall state that the mare did not produce a live foal. It is further agreed that should the above stallion die or become unfit for service during this or the season immediately following the one in which the original breeding fee has been paid and the mare does not have a live foal, the breeding fee, less booking fee, will be returned as long as the Mare Owner is entitled to return privileges as stated above. If the mare dies or becomes unfit to breed, another mare may be substituted with the stallion owner's consent. Breeder's certificates are issued after notification that the foal is born.
- (7) It is understood that neither Whispering Pines Farm, employees, guests, or veterinarian will be responsible for accident, sickness or death of a stallion, mare and/or foal. Whispering Pines Farm shall exercise its best judgement in the care and supervision of the stallion, mare and foal and shall not be liable for death, injury, or sickness of stallion, mare, and/or foal.
- (8) The breeding season for the purposes of this contract shall begin February 1 and close July 1 for the year of the contract.
- (9) Mare Owner agrees to the following expenses: Board Per Day _____ Mare Care _____ WET _____ DRY _____

SHIPPED SEMEN:

- (A) A non-refundable booking fee of \$ _____ due at signing and acceptance of this contract.
- (B) An additional deposit of \$ _____ will be necessary for the following _____
- (C) Semen collection and packaging fee: \$125.00 per shipment; \$200.00 for AIR counter – to counter Shipping Charges Extra
- (D) Reservations for transported semen, upon receipt of the above mentioned stallion fee confirms the mare's reservation to breed for the present breeding season.

(E) All requests for semen shipments shall be filled as received subject to availability of semen and the approval of Whispering Pines Farm. If there is insufficient semen to fill an order on a given day, Whispering Pines Farm will determine which orders will be honored. This decision will be based on the information provided by the attending veterinarians.
